

GLENDORA TRAILS ACTIVITIES

SATURDAY MORNING TRAIL HIKES

Glendora Trails Council members conduct these hikes. Children 12 and under must have adult supervision. No pets, please! Members should bring a day-pack with 3 quarts of water and snacks. Long pants are recommended. Sunscreen, water, and a hat may be needed. Due to difficulty level, trail length and size of the group, hiking times may vary. All members will be required to sign and fill out a hike liability form. The difficulty level is determined for those who do very little hiking. There is no registration or fee required.**

Colby – Colby Dalton Trails

June 27, 2015, 8:00 a.m.

This is a moderate to strenuous 2.3-mile walk. Park at the north terminus of Loraine Avenue at the south trailhead of Colby Trail. The hike begins here and travels north and east to the junction of the Colby-Dalton Trail. The group descends into Little Dalton Canyon and turns west back to the starting point.

LITTLE DALTON CANYON/LOWER MONROE MOTORWAY/MYSTIC CANYON TRAIL

July 25, 2015 8:00 a.m.

This is a strenuous five-mile hike. Park at the first horseshoe curve on Glendora Mountain Road, 1 mile north of Big Dalton Canyon Road. There is limited roadside parking here. There used to be a campground at this location. If the gate on Glendora Mt. Road is closed, park at the gate parking lot, approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile north of the junction of Big Dalton Canyon Road. We will hike up the Lower Monroe Motorway along the Little Dalton Canyon stream bottom. The motorway turns southward and continues to the junction of the Mystic Canyon Trail. The group will follow this trail down to Big Dalton Canyon and follow the roads back to the parking area.

WREN-MEACHAM AND DALTON CANYON TRAILS

August 29, 2015, 8:00 a.m

This is a strenuous, 4.0 mile hike, from the Glendora Equestrian Center to lower Big Dalton Canyon via the Wren-Meacham Trail. The group will cross the street and take the Big Dalton Canyon Trail to the Coulter Pine Trail, Keiser Trail and back to Mystic Canyon via the Big Dalton Canyon Trail. Members will walk back to the parking lot via the Big Dalton Canyon & Glendora Mt. Roads. Park at the Glendora Equestrian Center on Glendora Ave. at the junction with Boulder Springs Rd. This is about 0.3 miles north of Sierra Madre Ave. The group will meet in the south area by the Trails Council Tool Shed.

TUESDAY EVENING TRAIL HIKES

Walks are designed for the whole family; however, check difficulty level indicated for each walk. No children under 12 are allowed without an adult. No pets, please. Bring a flashlight. Long pants are recommended. Walks last about 2 hours. Participants will be required to sign and fill out a trail liability form. There is no registration or fee required. Hike will be cancelled if it is raining at the time of the event.

SOUTH HILLS WILDERNESS AREA TRAILS

June 9, 2015, 7:45 p.m.

This is a moderate 1.5-mile walk, starting at the South Hills City Park at the east terminus of Mauna Loa Avenue off of Glendora Ave. The group will be walking the Toyon, North Spur, Alost Canyon & Big Dalton Wash Trails.

LITTLE DALTON CANYON VIA THE MONROE MOTORWAY

July 14, 2015, 7:30 p.m.

This is a 1.6 mile, relatively flat walk along the Little Dalton Canyon bottom, however the ground is rocky with several shallow stream crossings. Park on the east and north sides of Glendora Mountain Road at approximately 0.9 miles north of Big Dalton Canyon Road. The road crosses Little Dalton Canyon at this point at the first horseshoe curve. In case Glendora Mountain Road is closed north of Big Dalton Canyon Road, park as near to the gate as possible. We will hike up the Lower Monroe Motorway, as the dirt road meanders along the Little Dalton Canyon stream bottom. We will return the same way.

BIG DALTON CANYON TRAIL

August 4, 2015 7:15 p.m. This is an easy 1.2-mile hike along the stream bottom. Park at the Wren-Meacham & Mystic Canyon Trail Heads on Big Dalton Canyon Road. This is 0.6 miles east of Glendora Mountain Road. If you come to the amphitheater & campground, you've gone too far.

Each individual will be asked to sign a liability release form for each hike.
