

ORDINANCE NO. 1848

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA AMENDING SECTIONS 2.04.030 AND 2.04.040 OF THE GLENDORA MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDING SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

THE CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF GLENDORA, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 36516 provides in relevant part that a city council may enact an ordinance providing that each member of the city council shall receive a salary, the amount of which shall be four hundred dollars (\$400) per month in cities over 35,000 up to and including 50,000 in population; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 36516 provides in relevant part that compensation of council members may be increased beyond the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400) per month by an amendment to an ordinance but the amount of the increase may not exceed an amount equal to 5 percent for each calendar year from the operative date of the last adjustment of the salary in effect when the ordinance or amendment is enacted; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 36516 provides in relevant part that a change in compensation does not apply to a councilman during his term of office; however, this prohibition shall not prevent the adjustment of the compensation of all members of a council serving staggered terms whenever one or more members of such council becomes eligible for a salary increase by virtue of his beginning a new term of office; and

WHEREAS, Glendora Municipal Code Section 2.04.040, providing for compensation to city council members in the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) per month became operative on April 27, 1992; and

WHEREAS, since the compensation of the city council has not increased since 1992, the city council desires to increase the city council compensation in conformance with Government Code Section 36516, to be effective on April 27, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the salary from \$400 a month to \$700 a month amounts to a total increase equal to 75% percent, and equates to an annual increase of 5% for each calendar year from the operative date of the last adjustment, as authorized by Government Code Section 36516.

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2.04.030 of the Glendora Municipal Code is hereby repealed and deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 2. A new Section 2.04.030 of the Glendora Municipal Code is hereby added to read as follows:

“The ordinance codified in Sections 2.04.030--2.04.050 is enacted pursuant to Section 36516 of the government code .”

SECTION 3. Section 2.04.040 of the Glendora Municipal Code is hereby repealed and deleted in its entirety.


SECTION 4. A new Section 2.04.040 of the Glendora Municipal Code is hereby added to read as follows:

“Commencing April 27, 2007, each member of the council of the city shall receive, as salary, the sum of seven hundred dollars (\$700) per month, which shall be payable at the same time and in the same manner as the salaries are paid to other officers and employees of the city .The salaries prescribed by this ordinance are exclusive of any other amount payable to a member of the council as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by him/her in the performance of his or her official duties.”

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases, parts, or portions be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. The Mayor shall sign this Ordinance and the City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption thereof and cause same to be published at least once in a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published in the City of Glendora, which newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose; and thereupon, and thirty (30) days after its passage, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force.


