SB 54 TOWN HALL MEETING RULES

The City of Glendora will host a Town Hall meeting about Senate Bill (SB) 54 (De Leon), Law Enforcement: Sharing Data, on Thursday, October 11, 2018, in the Bidwell Forum at the Glendora Public Library.

Anticipated Start Time: 6:15 p.m.

Location: Glendora Library Bidwell Forum & Plaza
140 S. Glendora Avenue, Glendora, CA

Attendee Entrance: Doors to the Bidwell Forum will open at 6:00 p.m. Seating will be limited to approximately 200 guests, and on a first come, first served basis. Access to the Bidwell Forum will be made via the north facing doors on the Plaza.



Security Restrictions: Items prohibited by the City of Glendora, include:

- Signs with sticks or supports
- Animals other than service/guide animals
- Deadly weapons
- Laser pointers
- Megaphones or other amplification devices
- Mace / Pepper spray
- Any other items determined to be potential safety hazards

Alternate Viewing/Listening Locations: As mentioned, seating in the Bidwell Forum will be limited. The City of Glendora will provide audio of the meeting that can be heard from the Plaza.

Questions and Answers: The City invites the community to engage with a non-partisan panel - the goal of the Town Hall meeting is to educate and inform participants on the requirements, challenges and opportunities that SB 54 presents to local agencies. Questions from those in attendance will be allowed, as long as participants follow the guidelines below:

- All questions must relate to SB 54
- No use of hate speech
- No use of profanity
- No yelling from the audience
- No general immigration questions
- City of Glendora's stance on SB 54 will not be discussed

Town Hall Schedule: All other programming will continue as scheduled. The City of Glendora will communicate any changes with attendees as the need arises through email, social media, and the City's website.
