

MANDATORY CONSERVATION MEASURES

1. Using water on outdoor landscape in a manner that causes runoff onto adjacent property, private or public walkways, roadways, parking lots or structures is prohibited.
2. Using a hose that dispenses water to wash a motor vehicle without a shut-off nozzle or device attached to it that causes it to cease dispensing water immediately is prohibited.
3. Using water to rinse or wash driveways and sidewalks is prohibited.
4. Using water in a fountain or other decorative water feature that does not have a recirculating system is prohibited.
5. Using water on outdoor landscapes during and within 48 hours after a measurable rainfall is prohibited.
6. Watering turf (grass) on street medians is prohibited.
7. Limit watering of outdoor ornamental landscapes or turf to no more than 30 minutes per station per week and not more than 6 minutes at each water station per cycle is required. Water efficient sprinkler systems (i.e. drip irrigation, bubblers, etc.) which cannot adequately provide enough water to the landscape in 30 minutes are given an exception for an additional 15 minutes as long as there is no runoff.
8. Watering shall be prohibited from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from March 1- October 31 of any yard, orchard, park, golf course, recreational area, or other area containing vegetation with the following exceptions:
 - a) The irrigation of trees and shrubs shall be allowed by any means and at any time of the day provided that:
 - 1) The irrigation shall be confined to the area within the drip line of a tree or shrub.
 - 2) There shall be no run-off as a result of the irrigation.
 - 3) That the irrigation shall not exceed 5 minutes to each tree or shrub during any 24-hour period.
 - b) The irrigation of plant material within commercial nurseries shall be allowed at any time of the day provided that:
 - 1) The water is applied only to one plant or container of plants at a time; and
 - 2) The water is applied by means of a hose equipped with an automatic shut-off nozzle.
 - c) The irrigation of golf course greens and City parks shall be allowed by any means and at any time of the day for the purpose of germinating seed, promoting growth of sod, or leaching minerals from the soil for new growth purposes only.
9. Restaurants, hotels, cafes, cafeterias, bars or other public places where food and drink are served and/or purchased cannot serve water to the customer unless specifically requested by the customer.
10. Operators of hotels and motels must notify their customers of the option to not have towels and linens laundered daily.
11. Residential users must conserve in accordance with the water suppliers mandated water conservation tier established by the State. As of June 2016, Glendora has been assigned a 20% reduction compared to 2013.

A first violation will result in a written notice and requirement to schedule a Water Use Efficiency Audit within 10 days of the violation. Subsequent violations in the same 12 month period are subject to fines of \$250 and \$1,000 respectively. The \$1,000 fine shall be punishable as a misdemeanor.
