BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES (3-year term, two full consecutive term)

Meets 3rd Monday (as needed), Council Chamber, 116 E. Foothill Boulevard, Glendora - 7:00 p.m. Members receive no compensation. The Board of Library Trustees of the city shall consist of five members. Members must be registered to vote (Admin Policy 1.14) and reside within the incorporated city limits during their entire term of service (GMC, 2.32). This Board provides strategic leadership and serves as the creative catalyst for developing and implementing the mission, values and vision of the Glendora Public Library.

Disclosure and Regulatory Requirements: Members are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) upon appointment to office, and annually thereafter (Conflict-of-interest code), complete AB1234 Ethics Training and Brown Act Training within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter, and are required to attend meetings on a regular basis. Meets 1st Thursday, Council Chamber, 116 E. Foothill Boulevard, Glendora - 8:30 a.m. Members receive no compensation. The BID Advisory Board of the city shall consist of five members and must be registered to vote (Admin Policy 1.14). Members must operate bona fide businesses located within the District and that are subject to charges and assessments imposed by Section 5.40 of the Glendora Municipal Code during their entire term of service. Members must be current with the payment of charges and assessments imposed.

Disclosure and Regulatory Requirements: Members are required to complete AB1234 Ethics Training and Brown Act Training within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter, and are required to attend meetings on a regular basis. (Resolution CC 2014-43)

Members must be registered to vote (Admin Policy 1.14), reside within the incorporated city limits during their entire term of service (GMC, 2.16). This Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council and Community Services Director in all matters pertaining to the park maintenance, park development, recreation programs, human services, and community beautification.

Disclosure and Regulatory Requirements: Members are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) upon appointment to office, and annually thereafter (Conflict-of-interest code), complete AB1234 Ethics Training and Brown Act Training within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter, and are required to attend meetings on a regular basis. (Resolution CC 2014-43)

Meets 1st Tuesday (as needed), Council Chamber, 116 E. Foothill Boulevard, Glendora - 7:00 p.m. Members receive no compensation. The Planning Commission of the city shall consist of five members. Members must be registered to vote (Admin Policy 1.14) and reside within the incorporated city limits during their entire term of service and no person of the Planning Commission shall hold any other remunerative office or position with the city. (GMC, 2.12). This Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on land-use policy planning matters which guide the future development of the City.

Disclosure and Regulatory Requirements: Members are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) upon appointment to office, and annually thereafter (Gov Code 87200), complete AB1234 Ethics Training and Brown Act Training within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter, and are required to attend meetings on a regular basis. (Resolution CC 2014-43)

Members must be registered to vote (Admin Policy 1.14), reside within the incorporated city limits during their entire term of service, and be customers of the City's water division of the Public Works Department. This Commission shall act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on policies and programs related to water rates, conservation efforts and financial matters. (GMC, 14.22)

Disclosure and Regulatory Requirements: Members are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) upon appointment to office, and annually thereafter (Gov Code 87200), complete AB1234 Ethics Training and Brown Act Training within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter, and are required to attend meetings on a regular basis.
