**MISSION:** GLENDORA COMMUNITY SERVICES FOUNDATION is a nonprofit public benefit corporation organized to aid, sponsor, promote, advance and assist in the provision of public parks, facilities and recreation by receiving, investing and utilizing funds acquired through fund-raisers, donations, grants, gifts, bequests and other solicitations.”

**INTRODUCTION:** Most non-profit organizations are formed by individuals who identify a need and believe that by fulfilling this need they can make a difference. This is why the Glendora Community Services Foundation was formed. The purpose for creating a non-profit organization was to help the City of Glendora Community Services Department:

- Solicit funds in support of facilities, programs and services.
- Offer a tax deduction to donors for contributions.
- Apply for grants that are not available to government agencies.

**PURPOSE OF NONPROFIT STATUS:** The specific purpose for attaining nonprofit status and a 501(c)(3) tax exemption, is to be able to offer businesses, community groups, and individuals the opportunity to contribute or assist in raising funds to expand recreational opportunities, to increase programs and services, and to provide a vehicle for the development of new parks and the refurbishing of older parks throughout the City.

**HANDLING OF FUNDS:** All funds that are raised through the Glendora Community Services Foundation will be deposited in the Glendora Community Services Foundation checking account to be used for the purpose for which the funds were raised.

**ACCOMPLISHMENTS:** In 2014, the Foundation raised funds for the purchase and installation of playground equipment at Gladstone Park through the KaBOOM! Playground Grant. The Foundation has also donated funds to the Community Services Share-A-Wish program which helps low income families participant in City activities and classes. With an effort to engage the Community and support bike safety, the Foundation donated funds to purchase helmets and bikes for winners of the raffle at Transportation’s Bike Safety Rally.
