Dear Supervisors Barger, Hahn and Solis,

The City of Glendora urgently request the County of Los Angeles to share a portion of its Coronavirus Relief Funds with San Gabriel Valley cities. An equitable share of these Federal funds is needed for our cities to continue to provide vital services to those residents in the San Gabriel Valley who were counted in the population-based formula used to establish the County's apportionment.

As you know, cities and counties smaller than 500,000 population were shut out from receiving direct financial aid from the Coronavirus Relief Fund authorized in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security or "CARES" Act. However, we note that the CARES Act does not preclude a county from sharing its apportionment with cities that constitute its underlying population. Los Angeles County can expect to receive an estimated \$1 billion from the Coronavirus Relief Fund. San Gabriel Valley cities constitute about one-third the population of the County (less the City of Los Angeles which qualifies for direct assistance), resulting in a pro-rata share for the San Gabriel Valley of approximately \$350 million.

Our cities have worked closely with the County in providing vital services responding to the COVID-19 pandemic as a vested partner. By passing through a share of Federal relief funds to the San Gabriel Valley, the County can ensure that cities will not be forced to cut services at a time of growing need and not become a burden to the county financially. If granted funds, our cities will accept full responsibility for compliance with applicable U.S. Treasury requirements imposed on the relief funds.

We truly appreciate your leadership and strong partnership as we respond to the challenges of this unprecedented crisis, and we look forward to your response.
